

ORDINANCE NO. 180

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF PATTERSON  
HEIGHTS, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,  
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 73, REGULATING  
THE USE OF PUBLIC SANITARY SEWERS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Town Council of the  
Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

1. Section II of Ordinance No. 73 is deleted and the following  
Section II is substituted therefor:

"SECTION II. Application for permission to tap into any  
part of the said sanitary sewer system shall be accompanied by a tap-in fee  
of Five hundred (\$500.00) Dollars for each residential unit to be connected  
to the sewer. Such application shall be submitted on a form approved by  
Borough Council. A plot plan shall be submitted with the application  
showing the location of all structures to be connected to the sanitary sewer  
and the proposed location of the sewer connection."

2. Section V of Ordinance No. 73 is deleted.
