

Patterson Heights Council Minutes

March 2, 2009

Council members present: Hicks, Barsottini, Sadaka, Kinger, Nichols & Ceriani.

Officers present: Pegg, Roorback, Mannix & Denhart.

The minutes of Feb. 2, 2009 were approved upon a motion by Mr. Sadaka, seconded by Mrs. Barsottini.

The Sec. read a letter from Mr. Peterson regarding a refund on his Rental Inspection fee which was referred to Mrs. Barsottini

President Nichols read a letter from M. Baker, Jr. Inc. thanking the Boro for using them as our Eng.

Mrs. Ceriani read a letter from a property owner thanking Mr. Harker for his action when a tree blew over.

Mrs. Barsottini presented a report & bill for \$300.00 from D. Pella, Inc.

Kevin Flannery of the Peer Assistance Program reported he would make recommendations at the April meeting.

Resident Charles Jones of 7th St. spoke in favor of the Patt. Twp. Police Dept. & Mrs. McCune agreed with Mr. Jones.

Mrs. Roorback reported tax collections for Feb. in the amount of \$6470.82.

Mayor Pegg reported that he will try to obtain donations for a park bench by the Memorial, also adding new names & advised that the playground grant has been approved.

Mayor Pegg read the Police Report showing 18 calls for Feb. & advised that the NIMS course should be completed by April 1.

Mr. Mannix reported that the new Rental Ord. had been published. It was moved by Mr. Kinger, seconded by Mrs. Barsottini & passed to adopt the Rental property Ord.

Streets: Mr. Sadaka reported surface water complaints on 4th Ave., referred to Mr. Harker.

Mr. Harker reported that the old catch basin at 8th Ave. & 5th St. will have to be replaced. Mr. Harker also advised that the Boro needs long barricades at \$165.00 each, & signs at \$135.00 each. It was moved by Mr. Sadaka, seconded by Mr. Barsottini & passed to buy 2 barricades & 2 signs.

Mr. Harker reported a new air compressor would cost \$799.00 & he was authorized to look into further prices.

The Sec. reported that flow meter results on Fern Ave. will be sent to us by Patt. Twp.

Recycling: Mrs. Ceriani reported on brush pick up, with several options: The Boro could charge a flat annual fee, purchase bags, or have the pick up remain as is. Mrs. Ceriani also advised that the Boro could have a paper retrieval bin for recycling, & Mr. Harker stated that we might remove the gate at the playground so a truck could enter to remove the bin.

It was moved by Mrs. Barsottini, seconded by Mr. Kinger & passed to adopt the paper retrieval program.

Mr. Kinger recommended a flat fee for brush pick up & is looking at wood chippers.

It was moved by Mrs. Barsottini, seconded by Mrs. Ceriani & passed to approve a contract with the City of Beaver Falls to provide Police Service for Patt. Hgts. effective 3/2/09 in the amount of \$ 26000.00. The Vote was 5 to 1 to pass the motion.

Mrs. Ceriani reported that the Ordinances have been indexed by Mr. Livingston.

Council adjourned into executive session to discuss personnel matters.

After reconvening, it was moved by Mr. Hicks, seconded by Mr. Sadaka & passed to increase the hourly rate of Mr. Standerford by \$.50 effective this date.
