Cookie Langle 61607th St. Her also for the sewer back up and water issues in her alley (fern). Her garage is getting a lot of water run off. Also would like to thank the fire dept. for helping that nite.

Bryan Landman 702 6th Ave. Here to complain about sewer back up in his basement. Would like to know what the boroughs emergency plan and hazard mitigation plan is?

Mr. & Mrs. Mendacino 619 7th St. Came to also let council know about sewer back up at there home.

The Hendry 608 7th Ave. Here tonight to let council know this is the 4th time she has been flooded with sanitary & storm water. Also water from the borough property drains into there property.

Mr. Barsottini then spoke to the visitors about the sewer issues. Are area has had 4 one hundred year storms in 2011. The borough is looking into increasing the size of lines. There were over 186,000 insurance claims because of the recent storms and 99% of all claims were denied. He stated you can get flood insurance for \$129 a year, also get sewer & water back insurance, install a back flow preventer and earth movement insurance to help you in the future. Also spoke on ways to prevent flooding at homes.

Code Enforcement: Mr. Barsottini read the August and September code reports.
