

Paterson Heights Council Minutes
September 14,2009

Council members present:Hicks,Nichols,Barsottini,Andrews,Sadaka,Ceriani & Kinger.
Officers present:Mannix,Pegg & Denhart.

The minutes of the July meeting were approved upon a motion by Mr.Sadaka,seconded by Mr.Hicks.

The Secretary read a letter from the Beaver County Comissioners regarding a meeting to be held regarding possible changes in tax collections.Mr.Kinger will attend the meeting.

The Secretary read a letter from Mayor Pegg announcing his retirement as Mayor as of Dec.31,2009.

President Nichols announced a fall Leadership Program & a Natural Gas Summit.

Mrs.O'Hara of 419 8th Ave.advised council that if anyone has a problem,she would like to be notified in person.

Police Chief Jones gave the police reports for July & August,and advised that the problems in the 400 block of 8th Ave.seem to have been addressed.Mr.Sadaka asked Chief Jones to have the picnic shelter checked after dark.

Tax Collector Roorback's report advised that \$7034.80 was deposited in August.

Streets: Mr.Sadaka reported that one more sewer tap in will have to be added,& one more block on 7th St.will have to be added to the slip line project mking the total cost of this project approximately \$ 35000.00.Mr.Sadaka moved to amend the prior motion to slip line one more block on 7th St. at an additional cost of \$ 10000.00.Mr.Andrews seconded the motion & it passed. Mr.Sadaka also reported that Beaver Falls does not have a wood chipper.

After discussion on stop signs,it was moved by Mr.Hicks,seconded by Mr.Sadaka & passed to have Mr.Mannix make the changes so that council may vote at the next meeting.

Recreation:Ms.Nichols reported that the numbers were down for the summer recreation program this year & the program should be reviewed in 2010.

Recycling:Mrs.Ceriani reported that the brush pick up program was going well.Mrs.Ceriani also advised that the Borough Web Site is closing & moved that the Boro change the Web site from Geo-Cities to Go.Daddy.com.next month.Mrs.Barsottini seconded the motion & it passed.

Budget;Mr.Kinger presented the Peachtree accounts & a budget meeting will be held this month.

Mrs.Barsottini advised that there are 16 rental properties & 7 inspections are pending.

Mayor Pegg felt that council should be notified when any special functions are to be held & that the Monument Service went well.

It was moved by Mr.Kinger,seconded by Mrs.Barsottini & passed to donate \$250.00 to the VietNam Vets of Beaver County.

Police Contract:It was moved by Mr.Sadaka,seconded by Mrs.Ceriani & passed to continue the Police Contract with Beaver Falls at the rate of \$26780.00 in 2010,\$27583.00 in 2011 & \$28411.00 in 2012.
